Can you see the lion's face?


Can you point out all the different parts of the lion in the pattern?


Can you find the lion's terrifying teeth?

Well, we think that this suit of armour might have been made for a very special person - King Henri II of France (Born 1519 – died 1559).


Do you think this armour is fancy enough for a king?
