Object Guide Map

Locations

- 1 Gladius and scabbard mount**
Located on floor 2 in the War Gallery, at the end of the Early War hall.
- 2 Ballock dagger**
Located on floor 2 in the War Gallery, in the Knighthood and Chivalry display case between the Agincourt battlefield model and replica tomb of Sir William Harcourt.
- 3 Flintlock military musket, land service pattern 1730 (Brown Bess):**
Located in the object case to the right of the fireplace on floor 2 in the War Gallery.
- 4 King Henry VIII's Tonlet armour**
Located at the far end of the Tournament Gallery on floor 2.
- 5 Centrefire self-loading rifle-Tokarev SVT-40**
Tokarev SVT-40: Located on floor 3 in the war Gallery in the Firelight (Second World War) Section opposite the 'Swift' training rifle target wall.
- 6 Sikh helmet**
Located on floor 4 in the Asia and Africa Gallery, in the immediate area around the elephant armour behind the two horse armour displays in the left corner of the left-hand case.
- 7 Naginata**
Located on floor 4 in the Asia and Africa Gallery, in the Japanese section across from the large sword display case.
- 8 Tula Garniture**
Located on floor 4 in the Self Defence Gallery, under the stairs.
- 9 Rimfire lever-action magazine rifle - Winchester 'model 1866' and Chevaliere d'Eon's sword**
Located on floor 5. Take the gold lift to floor 5, go down the hallway, turn left at the bridge and go across, then turn right and go down the hall. Both objects will then be on your left.

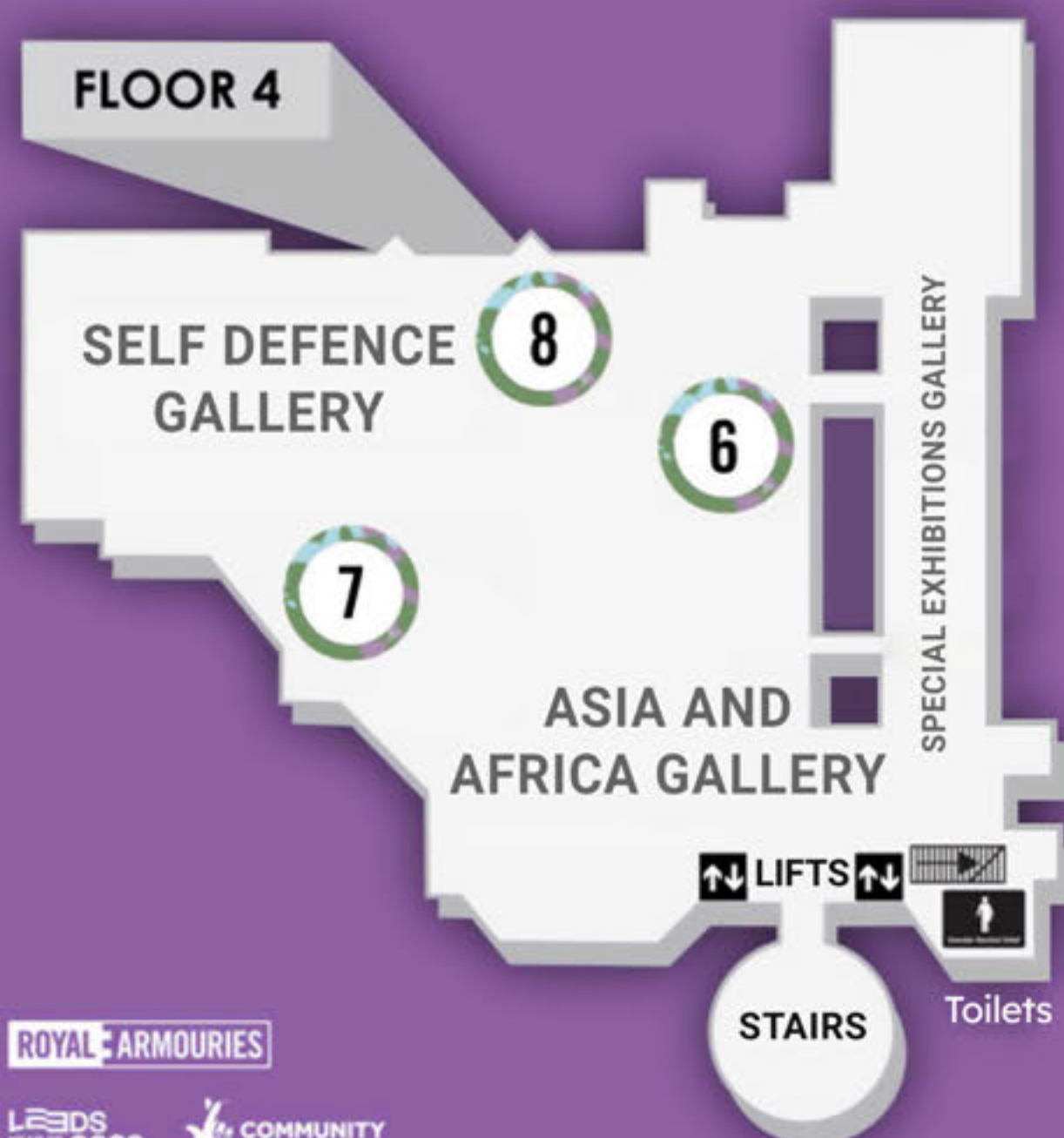
